OPEN BATHING PLACE

REGULATIONS.

Bathers paying first-class charges will be allowed on both sides of the Bath, and will be entitled to use the Dressing Boxes and Sheds on the North Side and West End.

Bathers paying second-class charges will only be allowed to bathe from the South side of the Bath, and use the Diving Board and Stage at the East End, and the Shed at the West End. They will not be allowed to land on the first-class side, nor to make use of the Ladders, Sheds, or Dressing Boxes reserved for first class Bathers.

Children under 14 years are not allowed to use the Bath during hours reserved for Adults unless accompanied by an Adult for the purpose of tuition.

Every Bather must wear drawers or a bathing costume.

Soap will not be allowed to be used in the Bath.

Dogs will not be admitted.

Any Bather committing an act of indecency, using obscene language, climbing up the banks or fences, doing any injury to the Bath or fences, trespassing on the roof of the Shed or Boxes, infringing the regulations or in any other way misconducting himself will be expelled.
